



Stephanie Bond's Top 10 Tips for Writing a Great BODY MOVERS Kindle Worlds Story!

Writing and submitting a BODY MOVERS Kindle Worlds (BMKW) story will cost you nothing but time, and you'll earn royalties on the sales of your story! Ready? Let's do this!

- 1) Learn the BODY MOVERS world—readers will want to see characters they're familiar with do new and interesting things. For a character refresher, check out the [Meet the BODY MOVERS Characters](#) page on [www.BodyMoversFanFiction.com](#). (There you'll also see illustrations of the BODY MOVERS characters!)
- 2) Sample current BMKW stories to see what has and hasn't been done in the BODY MOVERS fan fiction world. Read reviews to get a better idea of what readers like/don't like. [Click here for a link to BMKW stories!](#)
- 3) Chat with other BMKW authors on [www.BodyMoversFanFiction.com](#) to ask them what feedback they've received from readers.
- 4) Stumped for a BMKW story idea? Check out [Story Starters on BodyMoversFanFiction.com](#).
- 5) Your BMKW story should be at least 5,000 words, but note that longer stories (more than 10,000 words) are more popular. (A helpful way to visualize how long your story is/would be is to divide the wordcount by 250 to determine the approximate page count.)
- 6) It might be helpful to write a short "blurb" for your BMKW story before you get started to crystallize your main idea (think of book back cover copy), then write a longer (1 page?) synopsis to collect your ideas and put them in loose chronological order.
- 7) Even in novellas or short stories, you can subdivide your BMKW story into chapters or parts to help you plan your BMKW story, and help your reader enjoy the story in a familiar format.
- 8) When writing your BMKW story, keep in mind the irreverent tone of the BODY MOVERS series—readers will appreciate and respond to humorous moments!
- 9) Have someone read your BMKW story for typos and other mistakes you might miss.
- 10) When you design your BMKW cover using the Amazon Cover Creator wizard, you can choose from a library of BODY MOVERS images. For best results, keep your cover clean and bright; use simple fonts and leave plenty of "white space" so your BMKW cover will look great at thumbnail size, which is the size readers most often see when browsing online.
- 11) **Bonus tip:** When your BMKW story goes live, don't forget to start a topic on [www.BodyMoversFanFiction.com](#), post to the [BodyMoversFanFiction Facebook page](#), and use social media to let your friends know!
